

GENERAL HOTEL INFORMATION

Troutbeck Resort is situated at the foot of ancient pine-treed hills and overlooking a trout filled lake. The resort was built and founded by Major Herbert MacIlwaine in 1947 and has undergone considerable changes over the years, however, its famous log fire has never been put out since it was lit at the resort opening.

The resort is 6 500 feet (2 200m) above sea level with the surrounding mountains climbing to 8 508 feet (2 593m) above sea level. This inviting resort is perfectly positioned to explore the scenic beauty of Nyanga and savour the crisp mountain air. Troutbeck Resort provides friendly and efficient service in one of Africa's finest countryside locations.

Twin rooms
